ADVENT

This **year** Advent begins on Sunday 27th November. The word *Advent* comes from the Latin *adventus*, which means a coming or arrival. In the Church, it refers to the period encompassing the four Sundays prior to Christmas. It is a time of penance, of turning away from sin and hopeful, joyous preparation for the coming of the Saviour. This is what makes Advent special for Christians: the recognition that Christmas is not just "the birthday of Jesus," but a celebration of his coming into our world today, here and now. During Advent we will 'prepare' for Jesus' arrival by reflecting on the themes of hope, love, joy and peace.
