HEALTHY SCHOOL INITIATIVE Packed lunches

As a healthy school we promote healthy eating and would request your co-operation in encouraging the children to bring healthy nutritious choices in their packed lunches. No fizzy drinks please and biscuits, cakes and crisps should be limited wherever possible. Grapes MUST be cut up length ways.

Due to the fact we have children in school with allergies we request that there are no eggs, nuts or coconuts allowed in packed lunches, snacks or in school.

Children are also encouraged to bring a small bottle of water **(not juice)** to school to keep in the classroom.

This bottle will be brought into school each day and taken home each night to be refilled.

KS2 children can bring a piece of fruit for morning break. KS1 receive fruit in school through a Government scheme. Please ensure that your children wear the appropriate uniform at all times. Our uniform policy is on our school website but here is a handy reminder below
